## KS2 Swimming Requirements of the National Curriculum 2018-2019

**Sport Premium 2018-2019 funding focus**: To increase the percentage of children meeting the swimming requirements of the national curriculum by the end of Key Stage Two.



# **AUTUMN 2018 Swimming Update**

FOCUS: Additional targeted swimming provision – the impact on participation and attainment in swimming.

Currently 68% of Year 5 pupils who attended swimming lessons in Year 4 achieved the swimming requirements of the national curriculum. School wish to increase the number of children meeting the swimming requirements of the national curriculum by the end of KS2.

School have allocated Sport Premium funding to allow the Year 5 pupils who have not yet achieved the swimming requirements of the national curriculum to continue to receive swimming tuition.

# **SPRING 2019 Swimming Update**

At the end of Year 4, 68% of the current Year 5 pupils had achieved the expected standard for the swimming requirements of the national curriculum.

From Autumn 2018, school identified and targeted all Year 5 pupils who had not yet achieved the swimming requirements of the national curriculum, at the end of the swimming lessons provided in Year 4.

Of the 19 pupils identified, 12 have now achieved the national curriculum swimming requirements. This means the percentage of Year 5 pupils who have achieved the national curriculum swimming requirements has increased from 68% to 88%. This is expected to increase again in the Summer Term 2019.

# **SUMMER 2019 Swimming Update**

#### **Summer 2019 Outcome:**

Of the 19 pupils identified, 16 have now achieved the national curriculum swimming requirements. This means the percentage of current Year 5 pupils (2018-2019) who have achieved the national curriculum swimming requirements has increased from 68% to 95%.

The current percentages Year 6 pupils (2018-2019) who have achieved the national curriculum swimming requirements increased to 93% through additional targeted provision in Year 5.
