The all girls club has come a long way since it was founded with four girls who were disenchanted at the lack of opportunity to play football with professional coaches. The club now provides football for girls for approximately 70 girls from age 5 - 15 in Lowton and Golborne and the surrounding area.

For the 2020-2021 season, we have 5 Teams in the age groups of Little Stars and U10s, U12's, U14's, and U15's.

Our teams compete on Saturdays in the South Manchester Girls League (SMGFL) and local tournaments during the Summer with our previous U16s team competing in national tournaments and twice playing in the Lancashire County Cup final. Our Little Stars will be introduced to the SMGFL Development games once the season is underway.

We are always looking for new players to join GGFC. No matter what age or ability, your daughter will always be made welcome to attend our sessions conducted by our friendly coaches who make the training sessions fun and game related. All our coaches are CRB checked and attend FA Safeguarding and First Aid courses and complete FA coaching qualifications. As part of the Golborne Sports JFC, in June 2012 the club gained The FA Charter Standard Club award.
